## Guidelines for Visitors to Tsurui Village



## Stop idling!

Stop idling...Turn off the engine when stationary

Tsurui Village values the environment where Japanese cranes can thrive. Clean water and air are essential to this environment. Idling is one of the causes of environmental pollution. Please refrain from idling, especially at Otowa Bridge, where prolonged idling by cars is particularly noticeable.

Please refrain from leaving your engine running to warm up the car or for other purposes. If you need to warm up your engine, please stop idling within 5 minutes.



## Reserving spots is prohibited.

Please refrain from reserving spots with your belongings.

Everyone wants to take better photos. While securing a good spot is often a condition for taking good photos, reserving places with only tripods or other items is a violation of etiquette. Please absolutely refrain from doing so.

If you want to secure a good spot, please make sure you are present there yourself, rather than just leaving items.

We have received many reports of idling and reserving spots, which are violations of etiquette. Let's follow the "Tsurui Rules" and make this village a place where everyone can enjoy observing and photographing the Japanese cranes in a way that is gentle to them and pleasant for all visitors.
